Footprints in the Mud Gary McAfee

In John 8, 3-11, Jesus illustrates grace and forgiveness in its fullness. Here was a person who according to the Mosaic Law and committed an offense worthy of death.

The Pharisees, in their lust for power wanted to judge by the letter and trap Jesus at the same time. But Jesus' response is brilliant! Whoever among you who is without sin, let him cast the first stone. This simple response derailed the whole strategy of the Pharisees. Jesus did not deny the law or the penalty to be paid. He did not say to stone her, which would have been contrary to his teachings (Having received publicans and harlots). Of a truth, the Pharisees at this point, whether they would admit it or not, realized that they were dealing with something bigger than themselves. After all of the accusers seemed to be overcome by their own consciences and stole away Jesus said to the woman, neither do I condemn you, go and sin no more.

I believe that Jesus sensed true repentance in her and by not condemning her under the law, allowed her to prove her repentance by extending grace.

I guess one question that begs to be asked is: If Jesus can forgive us this much, why can we not forgive each other this much? The world would be a different place!
