What a great month with Southwest Baptist University joining us again! They have been working at the Dream Center and WOW it is coming so close to be completed! We are hoping to have an open house for our Native Youth in June!!! We did prayer walks in Wounded Knee, which was amazing. Many came out of their homes and walked and prayed with us. We also spent lots of time with the children, feeding them lunch, games, prayer and so many relationships built. One day we sat and talked about Jesus in a big circle and had the children request prayers. There were prayers for a brother 15 years old who died, prayers for their moms and family, prayers for sickness and their community. Jesus is in the heart of these precious ones. The team helped us bring the story of Jesus to the streets which amazingly was very welcomed! We thank you for your most faithful prayers for hearts to be opened to the truth of the Gospel. It is written "pray without ceasing". It is making a huge difference in our walk here. The youth need prayers for protection against, gang wars, alcohol, sickness, abuse and suicide. So many other forces that take our children's lives on the rez. The Dream Center when fully operational has the goal of suicide being a thing of the past in these young lives. One home we were asked to go into was in Wounded Knee. There had been 3 suicides in that home in the same family. We went in and in a large circle prayed and sang to the Lord. We felt His presence and in His presence the dark spirits must flee!! He has called us all to do this!! AMEN!!! Thank you for helping us stay and be the light!!
