

HEART NOTES

Greetings to all our friends, praying for you daily and hoping in these troubled times you have peace. I pray that what lays on my heart will help others reach that of a suffering Christian. (Don't throw this way yet, hear me out!) Part 2 will come in November.

"Go, for he (Paul) is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before the Gentiles, kings and the children of Israel. For I will show him how many things he must suffer for My name's sake." Acts 9 15:16 Paul's willingness to suffer opened the way of salvation for the Gentiles. Paul described some of that suffering:

Are they ministers of Christ?-I speak as a fool- I am more: in labors more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequently, in deaths often. From the Jews five times I received forty stripes minus one. Three times I was beaten with rods:; once I was stoned; three times I was shipwrecked; a night and a day I have been in the deep; in journeys often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils of my own countrymen, in perils of the Gentiles, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren; in weariness and toil, in sleeplessness often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness-besides the other things, what comes upon me daily: my deep concern for all the churches. 2 Cor. 11:23-28 Paul is a good example of refusing to demand his rights because there are others who are needy. We all know of Christian's who are dying in China, Middle East and even right here on our soil in order to minister to them, and have been ministered to by them because of the grace with which they dealt with their sufferings. Suffering can be redemptive to the one who suffers. Suffering purifies us. Maturing in Christ is a process of being crucified with Christ. It means allowing our egos to die so when it comes our time to die physically, we will already understand the nature of death. Paul wrote, "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me" Gal. 2:20 Have you noticed that much of our Christian life is egooriented? Living the Christian life today requires that we do a lot of dying. There is a lot of ego that needs God's refining fire today. Love you! More to come......
