I thank you for your last newsletter, "Footprints in the Mud." I will share your powerful words with others. Thank you for your obedience in responding when God touched your heart. "Footprints in the Mud" is a powerful word!

In the summer of 1977 as we traveled across country, one of our stops was in South Dakota so we planned a visit to Wounded Knee, remembering the historic stand off. We also prayed that we might have the opportunity to meet some Native Americans. As we drove onto the Pine Ridge Reservation, we drove along the small roads. As we passed an enormous field of flowers, I sensed the presence of GOD. Then we came over a ridge, and there to our amazement we had stumbled upon a local Pow Wow.
