


A Sweet Lakota boy places stones for the altar, at the cross.

As the Lakota children place stones on the altar, (below) it is a symbol of their innocent lives brought before God. Way up on the hill where the cross and altar to Jesus resides is a peace like no other. The children call it "their place" to talk to Jesus. And they do! In all kinds of weather the first place the kids want to run is to the hill to the altar, when they arrive at the Dream Center. It has become a place of peace on the rez for the Lakota kids. The Tree of Life that is painted on the Dream Center wall with their hands prints as leaves and the stones they placed at the altar, is a reminder of the responsibility and honor we all have to help these kids learn of Christ and have a life more abundantly in Him. 
