Some facebook posts from the rez:

"A 13-year-old sixth grader has taken her own life. My heart is breaking already, and the day has just begun."

"This knife feels so good against my wrist."

"Ain't nobody care anyway, my life will be better gone as it is."

Between December and March, more than 200 teenagers on the Pine Ridge Reservation in South Dakota either committed suicide, or tried to......

We must not let these important life changing needs be left unfulfilled. We believe that spending time with them, taking them away from the environment for day trips, overnight trips, gives them a perceptive that their dreams and hopes can be accomplished. They begin to see there is more to achieve and become and that life can be good other than what only they have been allowed to see. With the trust of the tribe and families the ministry has now been allowed to take the children to many different places. While many have never been off the reservation, they are looking with wide eyes to places they have never seen. We believe this is long term seed planting!
