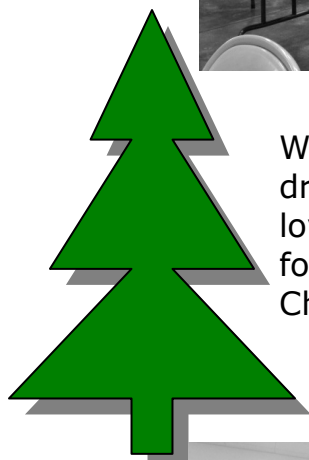

GED Program coming to the Dream Center

Brian, the ministries program director, will be implementing a school program at the Dream Center in 2016. The high school dropout rate on the Pine Ridge Reservation is the highest in the nation, over 78 percent. These astounding numbers moved Brian to take action. Brian is a former teacher at Little Wound School and education for the youth are important to him. He joined the WAEM staff in May. We are excited to have the ability to offer the teens transportation to and from the Dream Center with our van and bus. We will start the pilot program with three students and grow from there. Computers are needed for the Dream Center for this program. We will need new desktop computers or laptops for the students. Pray the Lord will direct our footsteps on this new path to help with the high suicide rates, giving education. ~
