



Corona update

The Pine Ridge Reservation instituted a "stay at home" shutdown for it's residents this month. This means that outreach ministry and ministry programs, prayer meetings, worship times have been a challenge. Without high speed internet that would allow us to live broadcast we are also at a disadvantage. The lockdown has made an already difficult way of life for the Lakota people even more difficult. The daily need has escalated for food, toilet paper, cleaning supplies and mostly the hugs they need. We here at Wings As Eagles Ministries have been working creatively to reach out to our partners nationally and with other organizations to facilitate supplies for the Lakota families. Praise the Lord, He is faithful during good times and mostly the hardest of times! The response from you our friends and partners and other organizations has been phenomenal! We have received masks, food items, toilet paper, hygiene products, paper towels and furniture from World Vision!

Help for food is still a need.
