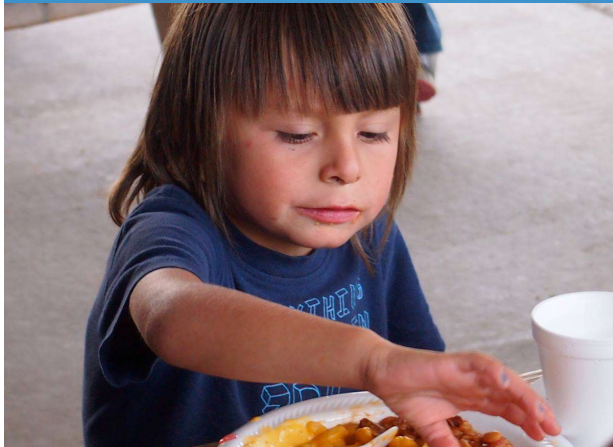


# VOICE IN THE WILDERNESS

4. Wrap the box and lid separately in Christmas wrapping paper.
5. Clearly indicate on the outside of the box the age and gender the gift is intended for. This is very important! You can use our Christmas Labels on the next page.
6. Mail your box to WAEM and make sure it arrives by December 9<sup>th</sup>.
7. Wal-Mart gift cards or a financial blessing is welcome!
